THE ARREST OF SPSU STUDENT LEADERS

On 29th July 176 1.30am Singapore Polytechnic Students Union(SPSU) house was raided by more than 15 plainclothes Internal Security Department agents.

The Union House was cordoned off and cabinets forced open by the agents who seized files and photographs on the pretext of looking for drugs. Foo Chin Yen President of SPSU, Foo Weng Fatt Chairman of the Council and Chai Chong, a recent graduate wer manhandled, handcuffed and let away. The entire operation was carried out without the agents producing search warrants for arrests, or allowing the students to contact their lawyer.

That same morning, <u>Lim Tiow Hui</u>, APSTIstant Financial Secretary and <u>Ng Boon Hwe</u>e a recent graduate, SPSU Social Secretary and <u>Chia Yei Yei</u>, a Polytechnic student w were arrested from their homes which, too were raided. Four days later, her sister, <u>Chia Yei Tse</u>, a former student of the Singapore Technical Institute, was arrested.

MOTIVE FOR THE ARRESTS

Although the most blatant and violent so far, the arrests are not the first r repressive move against SPSU. For the bast 2 years, the Polytechnic Adminstration refused to collect Union fees for the Union, hoping to cripple the Union financially Rumours were spread and students instigated over internal issues to the extent that the SPSU Vice-President was physically assaulted. Recently some active students have been called up by the Central Manpower Base on the pretext of National Service call-up and subjected to long interviews. Yet SPSU fought on and on and in the coming student elections, it looked as if the active and socially-concerned trend in the leadership would continue, and grow, despite all the obstacles.

The raid was well-timed on the dawn of the SPSU <u>nomination day</u> (for the coming Students coming elections). Three of the arrested studentsleaders, <u>Foo Chin Yen</u>, o <u>Foo Weng Fatt</u> and <u>Lim Tiow Hui</u> are eligible to stand for the coming council elections. Apart from crippling the Union leadership the label of "communists" is clearly aimed at creating fear among the student body and discouraging participation in the coming Council election.

TEE ACTIVITIES OF SPSU

In 1974 and 1975, SPSU worked with the University of Singapore Students' Union (USSU) in issues such as the Bangla-desh Flood Relief Campaign, Anti-busfare Hike Campaign and the Retrenchment Research Centre. After the banning of USSU in December 1975, the <u>Technocrat</u>, official publication of SPSU, served as one of the few publications honestly analysing the effect of government policies regarding Asean, drugs, Lee's visit to China, etc., on the majority of the people. SPSU has worked actively to enhance students, physical, academic and social welfare. The arrested student leaders were among those who and courageously committed time and effort in building the Union's potential and andorganisation that can voice critical and honest opinions for the interest of the majority of the people.

BE UNAFRAID

The Ministry of Home Affairz has announced without substantiation that the students (together with others, to make it more authetic) had been arrested for involvement in an underground satellite organisation of the Malayan Communist Party". We can expect that pressure will be put on the arrested students to make statement of 'confessions' as condition for release.

Such arrests and confessions will further serve to 'prove' the governmet's story of 'communist threat' and perhaps help the PAP to win back a place in Sociali st International at its coming meeting in September. They are also part of an overall strategy to silence and discredit all opposition before the nearing National General Elections and to frighten the people into voting for the PAP despite its high-handed policies.

Whenever criticised, the PAP will always claims that it has the support of the people, since it had been democratically elected. But the recent arrests to suppress opposition and spotage even student elections clearly shows what kind of 'democratic elections' we have. No country can progress if the problems of the majority are not brought up and solved. If we truly want a better life for ourselves and our fut -ure generations we must not be afraid to be more critical and SPEAK OUT.

《新加坡工艺学院学生报》 工艺学院学生会学生領袖被拘捕る件;

一九七六年七月廿九日凌晨一点三十分左右超过十五位便衣的内政安全局人员 交袭位於珊頓边的新加坡工艺学院学生楼籍口搜毒,他们将各个学生楼封鎖把抽 屉和櫃橱用暴力摆开所有文件及照比都被檢查.

符振洲,新加坡人工院学生会第十六届会长,胡荣友,大馬人学生理る会的主席及蔡 中一位刚星业的冈学他们被内政部人员蛮横的榜上手錶然後此走这一切行动 内政部人員都在不肯立示搜查令及拘甾令的悖形下进行,也不准学生联络分師。

当天早上,另外三位冈学也遭拘捕。林北辉,大马人,学生会副财政及黄訓辉新加坡 人,毕业生,学生会专任康乐主任,蔡燕与(一名工院互籍学生)在他们的宁中被捕,而他 们的住处也被内政部人員搜查四天过后又有一名学生蔡热子被捕。

这一項逮捕る件并不是第一項迫害工院学生会网学的手段两年来工艺学院当局 拒绝替学生会收会费养望学生会在财政上敷癀、校园内也不断有人在散播谣言而 在处理一些内部问题时有的学生更被煽动到打副会長量近一些较活跃的学生立 口民服役的条例下被征召而且进行長时间的盤问。但是学生会将继续战斗下去 在耒届的学生选举中, 至至至困难之下关心, 社会的领导层将会继续, 壮大,

这个内政部的侵袭刚好是在学生会新理分竞选提名的黎明,符振渊,胡荣芰 及林北辉是肯定会再参加竞选的除了妥削弱学生会的领导层外,当局还把共产党 的帽子要套在这几位冈学身上,很明显的是妥製造恐饰气免及阻嚇冈学参与学生 会 的选举.

至七四及七五年间,新加坡工艺学院与新大学生会至许多活动上合作如益加 拉教炎运动反巴士车费加价运动及裁员调查中心自一九七五年十二月新大学生 会被封闭后工艺学院的学生报便成为少校长夠忠果了析政府政策的刊物之一 如有关更細安吸毒る件,李总理访问中口为为时多少析,都是对广大人民有深远 影响的此外学生会也积极推动学生的体系学术和康乐活动这些被逮捕的囚学 把他们的时间和糕力都花车工艺学院的工作上,使学生会成为一个巨為太多校 人的利益而提立具有批判性和忠实心见的团体。

逮捕る件过后,内政部在沒有根据的情况下发表声明说这些学生是由于参与 馬来亜共产党地下卫星组织而被捕。我们可以预料到压力将加以这些网学身上使他 们"自自"或字"悔过也"做為积放的条件。这些逮捕和悔过得进一步的被政府甲表证明 失党威脅的确存在而且可以在九月的会议中帮行动党在社会主义门际中争回地位。

这也是在大选的未临之岁压抑反对党的一个步骤,风时也是恐吓人民必须委投行动党的特段 不管百对什么批评行动党常常主申他们是得到人民的支持的因為他们是在「民 主程序,下被选立表的,但是从号近的逮捕,压迫反对党以及破坏学生的选举中,我 们可以待楚的看到他们的"民主选举,到底是怎么回る.
